Dear Sir or Madam

Essential Maintenance on the A45 Southbound Offslip at Berry Lane, Wootton, on the Northbound offslip at Queen Eleanor Interchange and on the Northbound Carriageway of the A45 at Denford and Thrapston.

I am writing to let you know that we have ongoing essential maintenance work at various locations on the A45 between Wootton Fields and Thrapston.

We are clearing the ponds at Denford and Thrapston where we will use two way traffic lights. The traffic lights will only be in use at night between 20:00 and 06:00 from 17th September to 12th October. Off line works to the ponds commenced 23rd April.

We will also be clearing the ditch and repairing the drainage at the A45 Southbound offslip at Berry Lane, Wootton. The works will start on 16 July 2018 and we expect to finish on 27 July 2018. To minimise disruption we will work overnight, between the hours of 20.00 and 06.00, on week nights (Monday to Friday) only.

To carry out this work safely we will need to close the southbound section of the A45 from the Queen Eleanor Interchange to Services at Bridge Meadow Way for the first week only, with the remaining work done under lane closures. During the closures we will put in place fully signed diversion routes.

I apologise in advance for any disruption this may cause you. Please note that all planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
