

High Street, Market Square and College Street, Higham Ferrers– Carriageway Resurfacing

What we are doing: Northamptonshire Highways will soon start resurfacing works to High Street, Market Square and College Street to improve the condition of the carriageway and to ensure the safety of all road users. Although there may be some disruption caused, this is vital work and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT: Road Closure

Work Phases:

30/08/2022 – NORTHAMPTON ROAD TO QUEENSWAY

- Maintaining access to Queensway from Market Square end of the High Street

31/08/2022 – NORTHAMPTON ROAD TO WOOD STREET

- Maintaining access to Wood Street from Market Square
- No access to Wharf Road from the High Street. Access via Cemetery Lane OR Westfields Terrace

01/09/2022 – WHARF ROAD TO CHURCH WALK

- Maintaining access to Wharf Road from Queensway end of the High Street
- No access to Wood Street from the High Street. Access via Kimbolton Road
- Market Square will be closed on this day only. **No parking from 09:30 – 15:30**

02/09/2022 – CHURCH WALK TO CEMETERY LANE

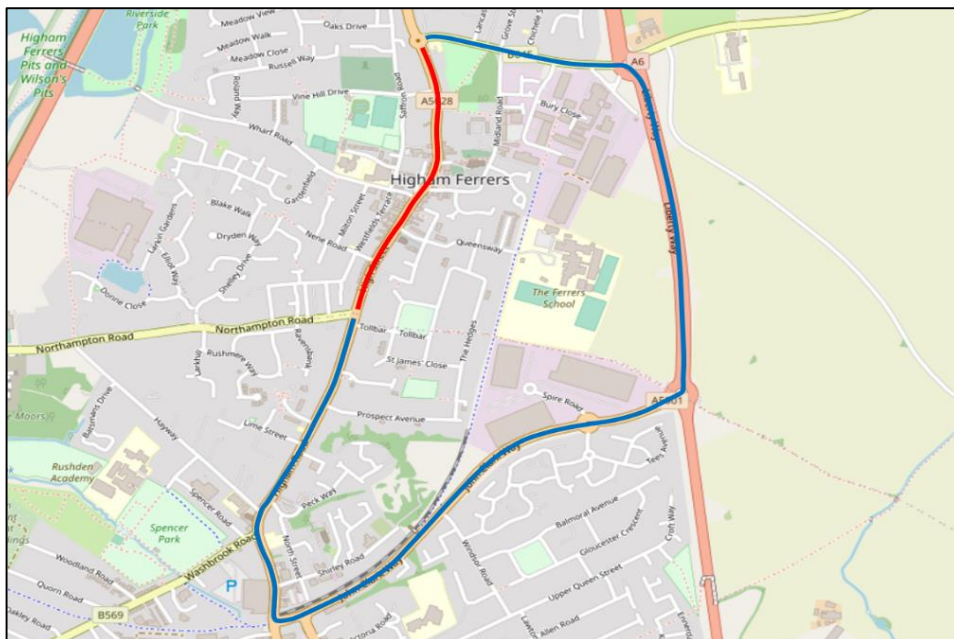
- Access to Cemetery Lane from Kimbolton Road end of College Street

05/09/2022 – CHURCH WALK TO KIMBOLTON ROAD

- No access to Cemetery Lane from College Street. Access via Wharf Road/Saffron Road

Traffic Management:

When programming works, we consider the impact on all network users and plan our works to minimise disruption as much as possible. We do understand that the closure will cause some inconvenience, but, works can only be completed safely and efficiently with this in place. We hope any inconvenience will be tolerated for the duration of the works as they are required for the safety of all road users. During the road closure, a diversion route will be in place during working hours. The **red** line shows the works extents and the **blue** line is the diversion.

Information for residents and businesses:

Access: Traffic management will be in place for the duration of the work, and vehicle access to your property/business may be restricted. We aim to maintain access and egress to properties within the closures; however, there may be some prolonged delays. If you require access within a section of the road closure, please speak with a traffic management operative who will be situated at each end of the road closure. It is advised that you allow additional time for any journeys in case of any unplanned delays. **We request that during the works, any vehicles that may be parked on the carriageway are parked elsewhere, legally.**

Businesses: If you are a business owner, it is advised that where possible, any deliveries to your place of work are arranged outside of the working hours/dates shown above. Customers will be able to park outside of the road closures and use the footways to reach your business.

Pedestrians: During the works, there will be pedestrian marshals on site to assist the public. Barriers will be installed along the footways to segregate the public from the work areas. Where required, footways may be closed and pedestrians asked to wait until we have stopped work and can provide a safe escort through the works area.

Cyclists: Cyclists should dismount and use the footways.

Emergency Vehicles: We will maintain access, when required, to allow emergency vehicles into the work area.

Towaway – moving vehicles parked in our workspace:

Parked vehicles that prevent or hinder the works taking place, may be relocated to a nearby adjacent street. This will be carried out by an approved contractor. Please look out for the signs in your street. We will try to find the owners of parked vehicles and Towaway will only be used as a last resort. Please ensure your vehicle is relocated away from the works area. Your assistance and cooperation is appreciated and means we will complete the work quickly and efficiently.
